WHY DON'T YOU WRITE A DAILY DIARY - EITHER ON PEN AND PAPER OR ON THE IPAD ETC? What do you see that is different? Hear? Feel? How is life different this week to how it was last week?

If history isn't your thing - you can do all of the above with any subject - dogs, cats, a famous footballer, space etc. Choose your own subject. Do a little every day - make it a long term, enjoyable project that you go back to and who knows - one day - you might be as famous as ANNE FRANK.
