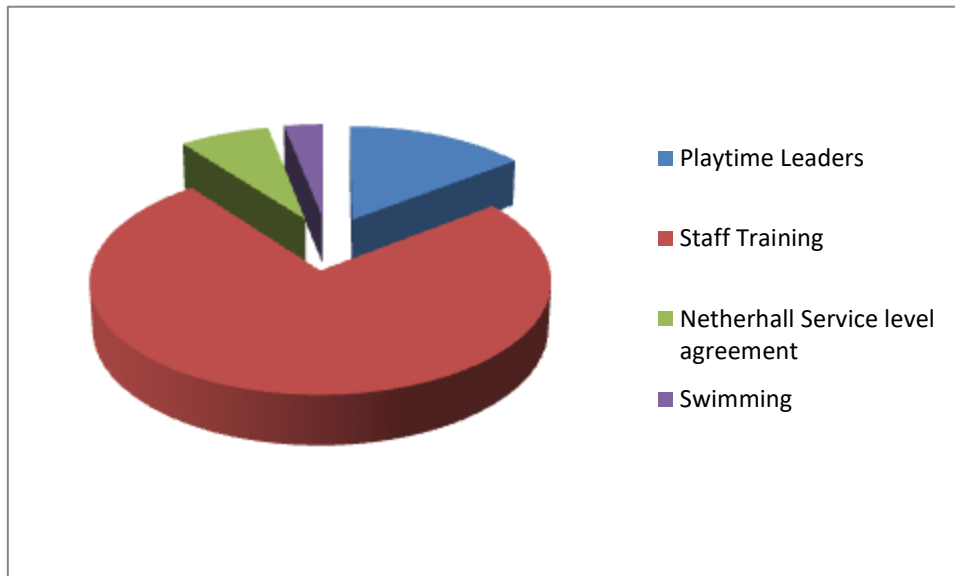


Primary Sports Funding

In 2016 - 2017 the school received - £8,850

The impact that physical activity has had on our children 2016-2017:

- Improved the teaching and quality of gymnastics during PE lessons and afterschool.
- Improved delivery of PE
- Children's physical activity experiences improved
- Sports leaders more involved with dinnertime activities
- Every child to run/walk at least a mile per day.
- All children have access to expert coaching.
- Sports leaders were trained - quality provision at dinnertime play.
- We had very successful sports teams - winning our cluster netball, rugby, hockey and football.
- Children are more active at Ewanrigg due to the increased amount of land.

Future plans - 2017 - 2018 - £10,290

- Increase further, the amount land our children have access to during playtimes, dinnertimes, extra-curricular times and after school activities.
- An outdoor gym to be located on the new piece of land.
- Staff to observe and team teach with expert coaches.
- All year 6 children to be able to swim 25 metres.
- Increase children's physical activity experiences.
- Every child to run/walk at least a mile per day.
- To increase activity during dinnertimes
