Planning and Teaching structure (Learning journey)

MFL is taught in mixed register classes through our Language Angels spine to structure our content of lessons. This is based on a two year cycle in lower and upper school.

Knowledge

Throughout the Key Stage children will develop their knowledge of French and learn greetings and simple sentences working to expand their wider vocabulary of nouns and verbs.

Skills

Throughout the Key Stage children are taught a breadth of skills in speaking, listening, reading and writing in French.

These skills will develop in complexity over the 4 years at Ewanrigg Junior School.

Assessment

At the end of each unit, children will complete an assessment task on each area of language – reading, writing, speaking and listening. This will be recorded on seesaw.
