Curriculum Procedure

Aims

At Ewanrigg Junior School our standards and expectations are high. We provide a curriculum which challenges students to 'Be all they can be!' We aim to develop lively and enquiring minds, with the ability to think imaginatively and critically.

We aim to provide a curriculum that meets the individual needs of all students and develops their abilities.

Planning

The school follows the statutory requirements from the National Curriculum 2014.

The curriculum is based on different 'projects'. Where possible this is linked throughout all subject areas to incorporate a fully cross curricular curriculum. However, we have recognised that this isn't always possible, therefore some 'projects' may be taught isolated from the other e.g. Science.

The curriculum is planned on a two year rolling cycle (long term plan) but this is constantly reviewed. There is a 2 year cycle for lower school (year 3 and 4) and a 2 year cycle for upper school (year 5 and 6).

The long term plan is then developed in more detail using spider diagrams and medium term plans. The medium term plans are in great detail; therefore these can be annotated and also used as weekly plans.

Curriculum organisation

The curriculum and timetable is constantly evolving. There are 24 sessions each week, as follows:

Spelling- 4 x 25 minutes per week

English- 5 x 1 hour minutes per week which incorporate 20 minutes of Guided Reading at the start of the sessions.

Maths- 5 x 1 hour 15 minutes per week which incorporates a CLIC intervention session.

Afternoon sessions- 10 x 1 hours per week
